1 Swing Set Safety Instructions

WARNING!

YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY DEPENDS ON YOU!

Observing the following statements and warnings reduces the liklihood of serious injury.

- 1. Provide on-site adult supervision for children of all ages at all times
- It is recommended that the playground equipment be placed in cocrete.Be certain that all anchoring devices (including cocrete) are placed below
- Teach children to sit in the centre of the swing play items, with their full weight in the centre of the seats. NEVER allow children to stand on the seats. DO NOT allow children to lean to the side when riding on other rides, structural members or collide with other playmates
 Dress children appropriately while on and around this equipment. DO
- NOT allow chidren to wear ponchos, scarves jewelry, loose shoes, jackets or clothing with loose strings and/or clothing that might be potentially hazardous whilst using this equipment

 5. DO NOT let children use this equipment in any manner other than
- intendedDO NOT let children use this equipment in any manner other than intendedDO anchor all play equipment .DO NOT install over concrete, asphalt,
- gravel or any other hard surface which may cause injury should a fall occur

 7. **DO NOT** let children use this equipmint until it has been properly
- assembled and anchored. Place equipment on level ground not less than six (6) feet (1.8m) from any structures or obstacles such as fences, overhanging branches, laundry or electrical lines, garages, sheds or houses

 8. Instruct children to avoid swinging empty play items. They may strike
- 8. Instruct children to avoid swinging empty play items. They may strike other children, or the play equipment may come back and strike you
- Instruct children not to walk closely in front of, behind or in between moving play equipment. Instruct children to keep a safe distance away to avoid being struck by the items in use


- 10. Instruct children not to twist chains or ropes , or loop them over the support bar. This adds stress, reduces strength and may result in failure
- 11. Instruct children not to get off play equipment whilst in motion. **DO NOT** allow children to jump from moving play equipment
- DO NOT allow children to climb or play on the eauipment whilst wet (silps or falls may occur)
- or falls may occur)

 13. Instruct children not to go down the slide head first
- 14. Check slide bed for extreme heat before letting children use the slide
- (when exposed to direct sunlight)15. **DO NOT** allow children to climb on or swing from structural members (eg
- legs, top bar and chin bars). These are structural components ONLY and NOT play features


 16. DO NOT allow children to swing play equipment more than 60 degress
- DO NOT leave hex nuts-tightened after completing assembly. DO NOT leave bolt threads uncovered TIGHTEN all hex nuts securely
- 18. **DO NOT** attach items to the playground equipment that are not specifically designed for use with this equipment, such as, but not limited to , jump ropes, clotheslines, pet leashes, cables and chains as they may
- to , jump ropes, clotheslines,pet leashes, cables and chains as they may cause strangulation hazards

 19. **WARNING:** lawn swings are designed for children over three (3) years of
- 20. At the end of each play seesion, remove all plastic parts and take indoors.
- DO NOT allow the use of plastic items when the temperature drops below odegrees
 21. Dispose of all packaging properly after the unit has been assembled
 22. Please retain the assembly manual for future reference and review each
- season
 23. This product is intended for use by children from three (3) to eight (8)
- years of age
