Installation steps



Install the auxiliary wheel and front wheel:

1. Install the auxiliary wheel axle into the groove at the bottom of the vehicle body. (Fig. 1)
2. Connect the front wheel power line, and put the front wheel assembly pipe into the reserved hole at the front of the vehicle body. (Figure 2 - Figure 4)



Install handlebars and front face:

1. Install the handlebar vertically into the body hole slot and fix it firmly with tools (Fig. 1-2)
2. Connect the front power cord and install the front wheel at the front of the vehicle. (Fig. 3-4)



Install the rearview mirror and lamp:

1. Install the rearview mirror into the front wheel hole slot and fix it firmly with screws. (Figure 1-2)
2. Insert the lamp. (Fig. 3)



Install the rear license plate, . Foot pedal

1. Hang the rear license plate into the groove of the rear body. (Fig. 1)
2. Connect the power cord of the foot pedal, and insert the foot pedal into the body hole slot. (Figure 2-3)



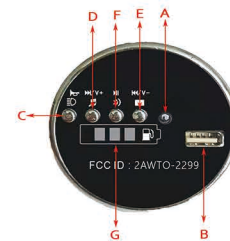
1. Remove the plastic cap of power supply,
2. Connect the body power cord.
3. Cover the seat plate.

- 1.Button start:Turns the vehicle on and off.
- 2.Forward/Reverse switch:changes the direction that vehicle moves from forward to reverse
- 3.Throttle grip (if eq up ped):Turn the grip counter clockwise to move the product till it maximum speed;Turn the grip clockwise to slow down the product till stop.
- 4.Mp3 player:
 - A.Auxiliary input:allow the audio from your portable music player or phone to be played through the vehicle speakers.
 - B. USB slot;Only support Mp3 for mat.
 - C.Turn on light and music
 - D.Music mode/Increase volume
 - E.Storytelling mode/decrease volume
 - F.Next: play the next song or wirelessly connected phone
 - G.Display screen:It displays the power level of the battery when the vehicle is stop.



- 1WD:when the numerical value less than 5, recharge the battery please.
- 2WD:when the numerical value less than 10, recharge the battery please.

Precautions for use

1. This product is not a vehicle. To ensure safety, it must be used under the supervision of a guardian.
2. Before use, safety education should be given to children.
3. The product must be assembled by adults and charged by batteries. The terminals should be red when the batteries are connected with the main wiring to red, black to black.
4. Driving vehicle shall be seated on the seat plate, and it is forbidden to drive in the street or in the area where motor vehicles are driving full ground driving.
5. It is not allowed to change the product structure and circuit system without permission, and it is not allowed to dismantle batteries, chargers, etc all accessories.
6. When you stop using or placing the product, please cut off the power supply and turn all switches to the stop or off position location.
7. Do not use any accessories that do not conform to the specifications of this product.
8. When charging, keep away from inflammables to prevent fire.
9. The charger and battery configured for this vehicle cannot be used on other products.
10. User age: 3-8 years .Maximum load: 30 KG

General knowledge of daily maintenance

1. After the first correct use, check the motor and steering system regularly (every half month is recommended) Check whether the screw is loose and repair the hidden danger in time.
2. Regularly check whether the wires, plugs, shells and other parts of the charger are damaged and found damaged If it is damaged, it shall not be used until it is repaired.
3. It is not allowed to change the structure and circuit system of the product without permission. Any failure of the electrical equipment must be repaired by professionals.
4. Do not cancel or use fuses that do not conform to this product.
5. The vehicle can be cleaned with a soft, dry cloth instead of car wax, water or gasoline.
6. This product shall not be stored in high temperature, near fire and wet place, and it shall be used for vehicles in snowy and rainy days Cover items to avoid contact with liquids and dispose of by professionals.
7. Battery exchange must be operated by adults, because the battery is heavy, and there is matching electrolyte inside, such as Avoid contact with liquid in case of leakage, and have professional personnel to deal with it.
8. In case of inadvertent contact, wash with cold water for only 15 minutes in time and see a doctor for treatment.
9. In areas with unstable supply voltage, it is recommended to install a voltage stabilizer to protect the battery.
10. It is forbidden to use inferior wiring or metal objects to link the battery level II, otherwise the battery will be short circuited.Damage circuit or cause fire.
11. It is strictly prohibited to use the car in the sun or rain.
12. Charge the vehicle in a dry area with good traffic and keep the battery dry.

Remark:

1. Please note the battery is not replaceable.
2. -Do not mix old and new batteries.
-Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries.
3. Make sure the charger is not connected to the car before starting the vehicle.

Maintenance

1. Parents should check whether the main parts are in good condition, battery, charger, wire, plug, jack and other parts are damaged before use. Whether the screw is loose or not, whether there is a hidden danger in the safety, should stop using when it is found to be damaged, until it is repaired in good condition.
2. Use a little bit of lubricating to lubricate the iron part of the vehicle for a period of time to prevent wear and rust.
3. Vehicles should be placed away from the fire and avoid long-term illumination. Keep them flat and up-right. Do not lean down. In wet weather, the car should be parked indoors or covered with waterproof cloth.
4. Vehicles should be far away from the warmer objects, such as stoves and heaters, plastic parts may melt, charging, away from inflammable goods, to prevent fire.
5. Please charge in time after use. Charging must be operated by adults. If it is stored or not used for a long time, it must be charged first and then every three months. To extend battery life.
6. Use dry soft cloth to wipe the vehicle, or use non-waxy furniture polishing material instead of soft cloth to wipe the plastic parts, so as to achieve the surface polishing effect, do not use chemical solvents to wipe the plastic parts of the vehicle, do not use soap and water to clean the vehicle, do not drive in rainy or snowy weather, water will damage the motor, the vehicle's circuit system and the vehicle. Battery.
7. When stopping using or placing the product, please cut off the power supply of the product and dial all switches to "stop" or "close" position.
8. Do not use fuse that is not in conformity with the crystal specification of this product.
9. Do not change the structure and circuit system of this product without authorization. The maintenance work must be professional or technical personnel. Conduct under guidance.
10. Do not use toys for other purposes.
11. Strictly prohibit battery short circuit.
12. Rechargeable batteries can only be charged under adult monitoring.
13. The battery is put in the right polarity.
14. The exhausted batteries should be removed from toys, and should be handled well to prevent children from playing.
