ANTI-TIPPING STRAP INSTRUCTION


1. Find spot on wall 1" below top of item.
2. Using a drill bit slightly thinner than anchor, drill hole into drywall.



1. Use a light hammer to tap anchor into hole.
2. Anchor should fit snugly. If hole is too small, drill again to increase hole size . Do not force anchor into wall.



 Insert drywall screw into metal bracket and into drywall anchor.
 Insert flathead screw into second metal bracket and into back of item along top edge.




1. Insert strap thru bracket attached to wall. then thru bracket on item, and into head of strap. 2. pull lightly til strap stops.

Assembly is complete.

HOW TO ADJUST HINGES

Gradually adjust the screws and close the door to review adjustment each time.



If door is too high or too low:

Loosen top and bottom screws, as shown in Fig. 1, for all hinges on this door panel. Take care to support door. Adjust door up or down as necessary, hold in place. and tighten screws again.



If doors have a gap in the middle or are hitting each other:

Loosen screw A and B, as shown in Fig.2, for all hinges on this door panel. Take care to support door. Adjust door to the left or right as necessary, hold in place and tighten screw A, then B. If the door is not hanging straight, adjust the top and bottom hinges separately by tightening/loosening screw B, to correct the alignment of that corner. Turn screw B clockwise to move door toward frame. Turn screw B counterclockwise to move door away from frame.

If door is too close or far from frame:

Loosen screw, as shown in Fig.3, for all hinges on this door panel. Take care to support door. Adjust door towards or awar from frame as necessary, hold in place and tighten screws again.
