
2.1) Attach Drawer Slide Bar (P) to Left Side Panel (B) with Screw (⑦) using Screwdriver (⑥). Insert Cam Bolt (③) into the mounting positions on Left Side Panel (B) using Screwdriver (⑥). 2.2) Repeat the same step with Right Side Panel (C).



3.1) Attach Drawer Stopper (9) to Middle Panel (E) with Screw (8) using Screwdriver (6).
3.2) Attach Middle Panel (E) and Back Connect Bar (D) to Right Side Panel (C) with Dowel (5), then insert Cam Nut (4) into Middle Panel (E) and Back Connect Bar (D) using Screwdriver (6) turing clockwise until tight.




4.1)Attach Drawer Stopper (9) to Front Connect Bar (F) with Screw (8) using Screwdriver (6). 4.2)Attach Front Connect Bar (F) to Right Side Panel (C) with Dowel (5),then attach Left Side Panel (B) to Front Connect Bar (F), Middle Panel (E) and Back Connect Bar (D) with Dowel (5), then insert Cam Nut (4) into Middle Panel (E) and Back Connect Bar (D) using Screwdriver (6) turing clockwise until tight.




5.1) Insert Cam Bolt (③) into the mounting positions on Top Panel (A) and Bottom Panel (H) using Screwdriver (⑥).


5.2) Insert Cam Bolt (3) into the mounting positions on two Legs (I) using Screwdriver (6).







Attach Leg (I) to Bottom Panel (H), then insert Cam Nut (4) to Leg (I) using Screwdriver (6) turing clockwise until tight.




Position the Leg(I) right side up. Attach Top Panel (A) to Left Side Panel (B) and Right Side Panel (C) with Dowel (5), then insert Cam Nut (4) to Left Side Panel (B) and Right Side Panel (C) using Screwdriver (16) turing clockwise until tight.




- 10.1) Insert Cam Bolt (③) into the mounting positions on Drawer Front Panel (K) using Screwdriver (⑥).





Usage For Cabinet Restraint Device



Attach Restraint Strap (②) to Back Connect Bar (D) with Screw (①) and Metal Gasket (③) using Screwdriver(⑥).



Drill mounting positions on the wall with Power Drill ((3)), insert Wall Anchor ((4)) into drilled mounting positions onthe wall with Hammer ((7)). Move the cabinet back to the wall, lock by Screw ((5)) and Metal Gasket ((3)) with Screwdriver ((6)).
