
This TV Stand has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the TV Stand parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




By hand, attach Wooden Dowel (③) to Left Panel (B), Left Floor Panel (C), Right Floor Panel (D), Right Panel (E) as shown above




With the help of your adult partner, insert the Wooden Dowel (③) on Left Panel (B), Left Floor Panel (C), Right Floor Panel (D), Right Panel (E) into the hole of Bottom Panel (G) as shown above Then secure Left Panel (B), Left Floor Panel (C), Right Floor Panel (D), Right Panel (E) to Bottom Panel (G) using Screw (①) and Allen Key (④) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.




By hand, attach Wooden Dowel (3) to Floor Panel (F) as shown above

Step 5




With the help of your adult partner, position Wooden Dowel (③) on Floor Panel (F) into the hole of Left Floor Panel (C) and Right Floor Panel (D) of frame on step 3 as shown above.


Fix wooden dowel on Back Bar (K) into the hole of Left Panel (B) Left Floor Panel (C). Repeat this step to fix another Back Bar (K) on product, as shown above.



With the help of your adult partner, insert 4 Plastic Washer (⑦) to the iron dowels on Door, put the iron dowels on Door (H) into the rail of Bottom Panel (G) of frame in step 6 as shown above




With the help of your adult partner, put the iron dowels on Door (H) into the rail Top Panel (A) as shown above




With the help of your adult partner, secure the Top Panel (A) to the Left Floor Panel (C) and Right Floor Panel (D) of frame on step 8 using Screw (②) and Allen Key (④) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws



With the help of your adult partner, attach Upper Back Panel (I) and Lower Back Panel (J) to back of TV Stand using Screw (⑤), and Screwdriver (⑥). **Do not fully tighten the Screws**

Step 11



Exert pressure floorwards, onto the TV Stand with both your hands.

This pressure will help the Legs and TV Stand Top reach full alignment status. Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

When tightening Bolts tighten sequentially.

Do not tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen Bolts and excute the same above process.

If the TV Stand is not STV Stand, it could lead to damage to the product.

Your TV Stand is ready for use.





Usage For TV Stand Restraint Device:

For TV Stand against wall, fix 2pcs Metal Brackets(9) on wall and 2pcs Metal Brackets(9) on product, use TV Stand Restraint Strap(10) to connect the Metal Bracket9) on wall and product. Find details as below:




A: Firstly, turn back the TV Stand outwards as shown above.

Then fix one Metal Bracket (0) on the Left Panel (B) of TV Stand by the 2cm Small Self Tapping Screws (8).

The distance between the top edge of the Left Panel (B) and bracket is 0.3 inch.

The distance between the top edge of the Right Panel (E) and bracket is 0.3 inch. Repeat this step to fix another Metal Bracket (10) on product, as shown above.




B: Find out the screw holes on the wall.

First, mark the point at same height on the wall as Metal Bracket (10) on product. You can find these same points in two ways as below:

- 1. Move the TV Stand back to the wall, make these points on the wall and product are at same height.
- 2. Measure the height of the Metal Bracket and the wall by ruler, keep them are accurately and same height.

(Caution: The TV Stand Restraint Strap(11)) between Metal Backets (9) on product and wall should be within 3.5").

Then fix one Metal Bracket (9) on the mark on wall by the 5cm Big Self Tapping Screws(9). Repeat this step to fix another Metal Bracket (9) on wall, as shown above.



C: Move the TV Stand against the wall. Then pull the TV Stand Restraint Strap(1) through two Metal Brackets (1) one by one, lock tight the TV Stand Restraint Strap(1) as shown above.

TV Stand Restraint Device is installed and TV Stand is ready for use.

Care & Maintenance Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish. Do not place furniture under direct sunlight. Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents. Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface. Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only .
