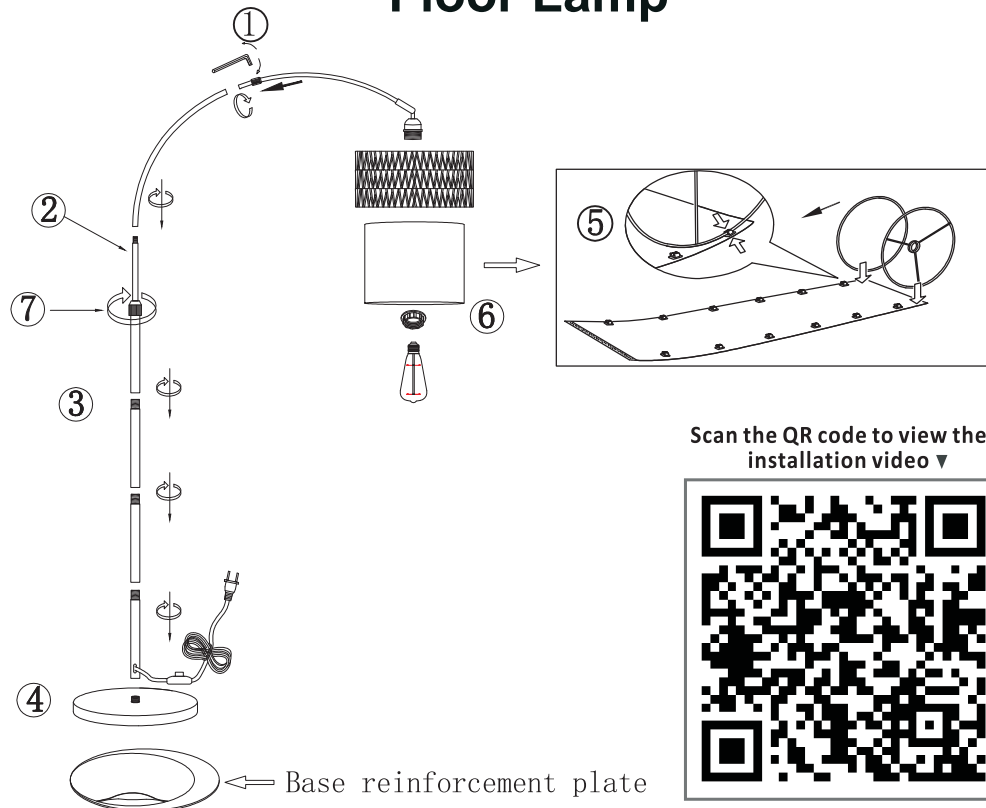

INSTALLATION STEPS

How to use the base reinforcement plate: Tear off the sticker of the reinforcement plate and stick it on the lower end of the marble base (Needed when you put the floor lamp on carpet or other soft surface).

1. Loosen the screw on the ring with the "L" tool, connect the 2 curved tubes and tighten the ring, and then tighten the screw on the ring with the "L" tool.
2. Connect the curved tubes to the straight tube and rotate until fully tightened.
3. Connect the 4 straight tubes in sequence and rotate until fully tightened.
4. Insert the assembled lamp pole into the marble base, rotate and until fully tightened.
5. Fix the 2 round rings to the top and bottom snaps of the fabric lampshade and stick the fabric lampshade seal in place.
6. Install the rattan lampshade and fabric lampshade on the bulb socket with the retaining ring, and then install the matching smart light bulb.
7. Adjust the height of the floor lamp by the knob on the lamp pole to get the height you want.

QUESTION & ANSWER

Q: After powering on, my lamp doesn't work. What should I do?

1. Please check whether the lamp is really powered on and the switch is on.
2. Please make sure the light bulb you are using is the good one.
3. Please check whether the copper pieces inside the bulb socket contact well with your bulb.

After these steps, if your lamp still doesn't work. Just feel free to contact us for a replacement.
