But don't worry, we will send a replacement or issue a refund in case the light is defective or stop working within 90 days after receiving. And, you don't need the hassle to return, just notice us

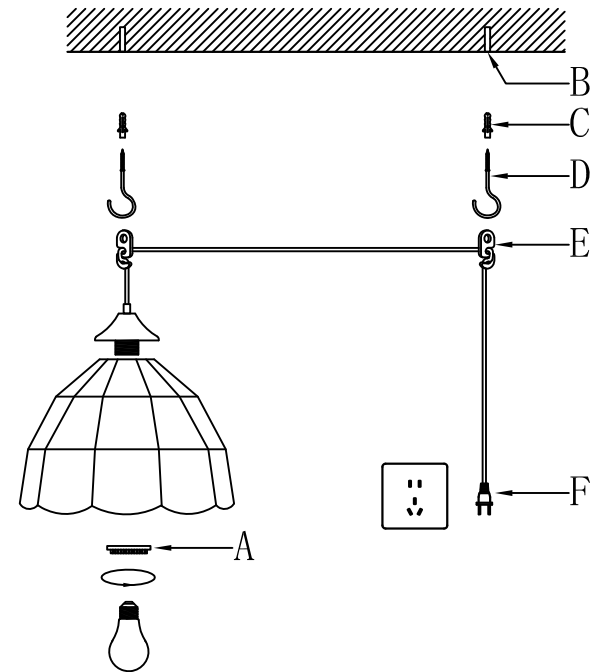

Package List

- 1 x Bulb Socket with switch and plug in cord
- 1 x Lampshade
- 1 x Screw Washer
- 1 x Pack of components including: Wire nuts (3), Screws (3), Dry wall anchors (3)

Cautions

- Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
- We recommend to wear gloves during installation to avoid fingerprints or your finger being hurt.
- unplug or shut off power when you screw a light bulb or change a light bulb.
- Do not look at the bulb directly for a long time or touch it when the bulb is power-on.
- In order to protect the light bulb and switch, please do not turn the dimmer switch frequently or too fast.



Installation Step

- Assemble the lampshade and the bulb socket together by screwing the screw washer, then screw a light bulb. (incandescent less that 60W or **dimnable** LED)
- Drill a 2 or 3 holes on where you going to hang it according to the size of the drywall anchors.
- Insert the anchors and then screw the hanging hooks tightly.
- Use the plastic hooks to hold the hanging cord according to the hanging height, and then hang the lamp onto the hooks.
- Plug into wall outlet and ready.

Notice: It's simple to install, but you need a drill. So, you may need a professional electrician to help you out.

Normal Trouble Shooting

The light bulb flickers constantly, what can I do?

- Please check whether the bulb you are using is a **dimmer** one. Regular LED bulbs are not compatible with the dimmer switch. Besides, incandescent and halogen bulb is the best recommendation to fit well. (60W max.)
 - Check if the copper sheet inside the bulb holder is loose.
- If it's not the reason above, just feel free to contact us for a replacement.

My lamp does not work when I first use, what can I do?

- Please check whether the lamp is really powered on and the switch is on.
 - Please make sure the light bulb you are using is the good one.
 - Please check whether the copper pieces inside the bulb socket stay well.
- None of these 3 steps? Just feel free to contact us for a replacement.

My lamp misses parts / is defective / has broken parts, what can I do?

Please contact us directly. We have spare parts in US warehouse. Necessary parts or a whole replacement will be shipped in 24 hours as soon as we being noticed.
