- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



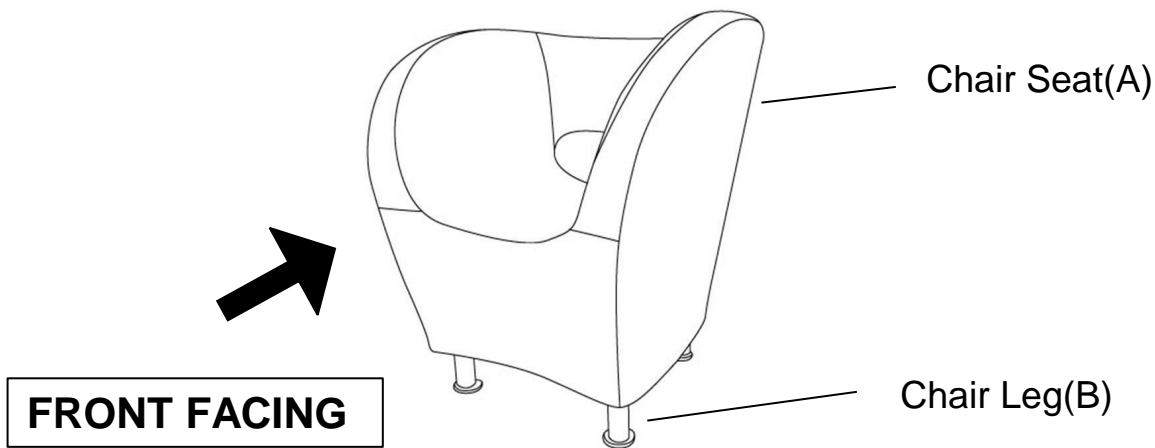
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

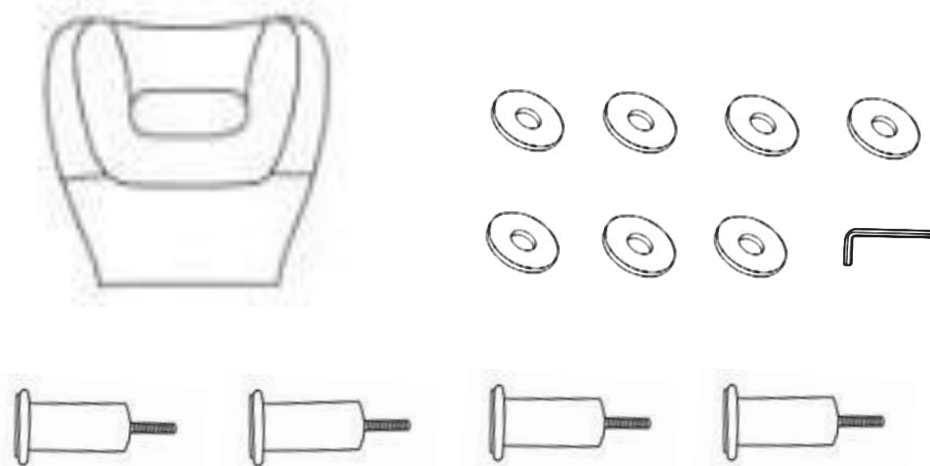
Assembly Steps

Overview



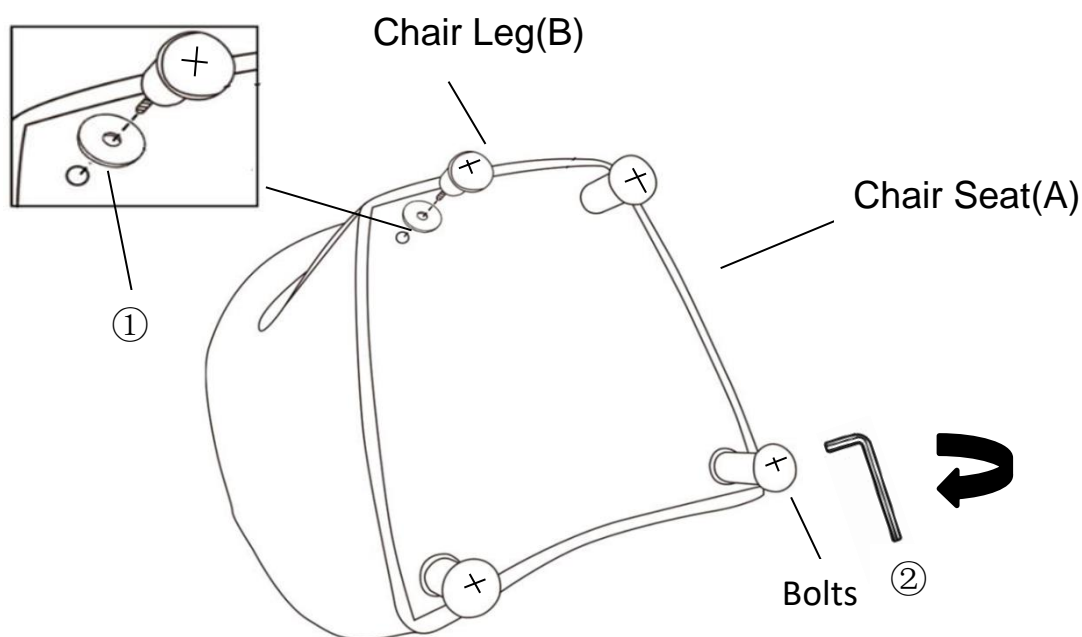
This Leisure Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Leisure Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



Turn the Chair(A) over to the bottom.

Install Chair Leg(B) into the Chair(A) by putting a Washer(①)(optional but improves security tightness and you can adjust the height as needed to maintain balance)onto the threaded stem.

Insert the threaded stem into the mounting position at each corner of the bottom of the Chair(A). Tighten Chair Legs(B) by turning clockwise.

Repeat the same step to install the remaining 3 Legs(B).

After all Bolts are in place, use Allen Key(②) tighten Bolts on Legs(B) fully in a sequential manner.

Step 3



Turn the Chair right side up.

Inspect and make sure all parts are connected and locked into position.

Your Leisure Chair is ready for use.

This Leisure Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
